After trimming about 500 feet, it is advisable to come back to a check day where our tutors will check technique and assist with development.

After a further spell of foot trimming, you can return and take the DIPLOMA exam.

The **DIPLOMA** is recognised as a mark of quality and high standard. It is accepted by the NACFT and many professional foot trimmers have taken the exam.

We run the course in a relaxed manner ensuring that cattle foot care is a pleasure to learn.
